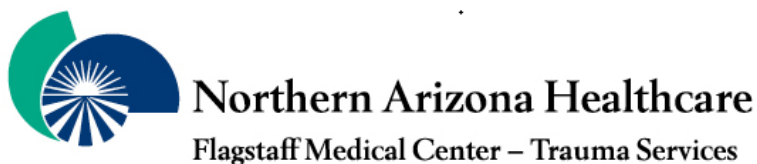




AUGUST 13TH, 2021 STOP THE BLEED INSTRUCTOR COURSES

Motivated by the 2012 tragedy in Sandy Hook and multiple tragedies that have occurred in the ensuing years, leaders from law enforcement, the federal government, and the medical community came together to improve survivability. The resulting injuries from these events generally present with severe bleeding which, if left unattended, can result in death. Providing first responders (law enforcement) and civilian bystanders the skills and basic tools to stop uncontrolled bleeding in an emergency situation, lives will be saved. **The next step is to focus on needs of civilian bystanders.**

Civilians need basic training in Bleeding Control principles so they are able to provide immediate, frontline aid until first responders are able to take over care of an injured person. **Due to many situations, there may be a delay between the time of injury and the time a first responder is on the scene. Without civilian intervention in these circumstances, preventable deaths will occur.**
